BATTERY REPLACEMENT

A faint display, no display, or operational difficulties indicate that the battery should be replaced. Remove the battery cover, located on the back of the unit, by sliding it down and lifting it out. Replace the battery with a new 1.5-volt, G-13 size silver-oxide battery. Equivalent battery replacements are: RAYOVAC RW42, DURACELL D357, and EVEREADY 357. Insert the battery with the positive side facing out. Replace the battery cover.
